IGO NGADJU VOCATIONAL TRAINEESHIP PROGRAM

IGO Nova Operations will be launching the Ngadju Vocational Traineeship Program in late 2018.

These positions will be located at Nova Operations, but not restricted to Nova Site.

The program will run for a period of 2 years of full time employment with IGO. A Vocational Certificate qualification will sit alongside “on the job training”.

POSITIONS WILL EXIST FOR THE FOLLOWING ROLES:

1. ADMINISTRATION TRAINEESHIP
2. LOGISTICS & WAREHOUSING TRAINEESHIP
3. PROCESSING TRAINEESHIP
4. MAINTENANCE TRAINEESHIP
5. OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH & SAFETY TRAINEESHIP
6. GEOLOGY FIELD ASSISTANT TRAINEESHIP

To be successful for one of these roles each candidate must be of Ngadju Heritage. This requirement is due to IGO's commitment to the existing Ngadju Mining Agreement.

The employment and professional development of Ngadju people are two core areas of focus for our organisation.

These positions will be advertised on the IGO website and across various community agencies and the Ngadju Native Title Aboriginal Corporation (NNTAC) website. Interested candidates will then be required to apply directly online.

COME WORK WITH US

- The Traineeship will be based at Nova, but not restricted to the Nova site
- Gain education and exposure to mining operations and systems
- The program will run for a period of 2 years of full time employment with IGO
- Role is Fly in / Fly Out (FIFO) or Drive in / Drive Out (DIDO) based at the Nova mine site
- The working roster is 8 days on and 6 days off
- In Perth at the IGO Corporate Office, the working roster is 5 days on, 2 days off (typically traditional work week of Monday to Friday, with Saturday and Sunday off)

ABORIGINAL EMPLOYMENT & BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT

NGADJU ADMINISTRATION TRAINEESHIP AT IGO NOVA

IGO is now introducing the Ngadju Administration Traineeship Program for 2018.

People of Ngadju heritage are encouraged to apply for this role at our flagship operation, the Nova Nickel-Copper-Cobalt Operation, located in the Fraser Range of Western Australia.

We offer both Fly in / Fly out and Drive in / Drive out options. Our flat corporate structure gives our people the opportunity to gain experience in many areas across our business – something most larger mining companies can't offer.

VOCATIONAL CERTIFICATE

The successful candidate will be required to complete an Administrative Vocational Certificate while learning on the job. This certificate will be managed by a preferred Registered Training Organisation. Completing and passing each module of the Certificate is compulsory for the candidate to remain on the traineeship program. Study sessions will be available whilst working the roster as well as site based mentoring and a buddy support system.

It is envisaged that the successful candidate will start their traineeship in the South Perth Corporate Office for approximately 3 months and then complete the remainder of the traineeship at the Nova mine site.
