

Dedication Ceremony

Please join in and celebrate the dedication of Ngadju country as an Indigenous Protected Area (IPA).

WHEN: 11:30 am, Saturday 20th March 2021

WHERE: Warranypana (Lake Cowan Lookout, Mort Harslett Drive, near Norseman)

Buses will be leaving every 15 minutes.

Commencing 10:45am, from the corner of Roberts and Talbot Street, Norseman. Parking will be limited at site.

Ngadju members who attend the IPA event can receive assistance with travel and accommodation.

Important Facts

Did you know:

In 2014 the Ngadju Nation's exclusive possession native title rights to more than 4 million hectares of their ancestral lands was recognised. An additional 270,000 hectares was added in 2017 to Ngadju native title in the Widgiemooltha area. Ngadju Native Title is bigger than Tasmania.

How is it managed?


With support from regional partners and the cultural and conservation knowledge of Ngadju Conservation Aboriginal Corporation (NCAC) and the Ngadju community, Ngadju land is managed and preserved using Indigenous land management methods.

What does this mean?

It means, Ngadju have been given back the use and care of their country to actively manage our land, waters, wildlife and cultural heritage. Recognition of our native title provides Ngadju the opportunity to bring our achievements together, and with agreement across the Ngadju Nation, establish an Indigenous Protected Area over lands we hold as exclusive ownership.

How do we help?

Support our Ngadju community to conserve our woodlands, Nullarbor plains and coastal areas. Come to the IPA Dedication Ceremony where Ngadju people and our Elders past and present will be acknowledged as the traditional land managers of Ngadju bunna.



Travel and Accommodation allowance

IPA Dedication Ceremony

Saturday 20th March, Norseman

NNTAC members who wish to attend and celebrate the IPA with Ngadju Conservation Aboriginal Corporation (NCAC) will receive the following allowance with travel and accommodation.

Allowances will be based on the following:

- Travel allowance will be calculated at 20c/km travelled from your place of residence. Your place of residence will be the contact details in the NNTAC membership register.
- Travel allowance is paid per vehicle with only one allowance paid per vehicle and car registration will be required.
- To claim travel allowance it is encouraged to be present for the entire event.
- Members travelling more than 250km one way (as per your place of residence in the members register) will receive 2 nights' accommodation allowance based on the ATO rate of \$114 per night (\$228); and
- Members travelling more than 250km one way (as per your place of residence in the members register) will receive a dinner allowance based on the ATO rate of \$49.60 per night (\$99.20).

The maximum travel allowance of \$400 will be paid to members who attend the IPA event from distances further than 1000km and payment will be paid within three business days after the event.
